Ammerbuch, Oct. 02, 2018: The vhf manufacture AG, manufacturer of milling machines, tools and CAM software for the industrial, sign making and dental technology sectors, celebrated its 30th anniversary this September. They benefit from an extremely high vertical range of manufacture as all of our products are developed and manufactured here at the site – this is truly high technology made in Germany."

The high quality standards are reflected in the machines and tools of the manufacturer based in Ammerbuch near Stuttgart. vhf launched two new products in connection with its anniversary: the K5+ dental milling machine and the vhf X – a large-format CNC milling machine that was recently presented with a sensational show at the leading metalworking trade fair AMB in Stuttgart. But vhf has made a name for itself well beyond the Stuttgart region. In 2016, the company opened a branch close to New York, enabling even better service for partners and customers in the USA.

This service concept plays a major role at vhf, as Frank Benzinger explains: “Our customers should be confident that they are not only purchasing high-quality products, but also getting the best possible service and support. Their feedback clearly shows us that we are well positioned for the future with this approach.”

vhf also sets high standards in its day-to-day business: As a sustainable producer, the manufacturer relies on solar and hydro energy while being committed to resource-conserving management practices. Social commitment in the region and beyond is also a core principle at the company.
