With the new K5+, on the other hand, dry milling is even more convenient: processing a particularly wide range of materials and indications with five axes, users will benefit from the tool-free blank fixer and integrated ionizer.

The vhf machines will not only be on display at the company's own booths, however, but also at the booths manned by sales partners Jensen, Pearson and Talladium as well as two new distributors who will be announced on the first day of the trade show.
